

Terms of Service - BareWanderer

Version 1 - Last updated 15-4-2026

These Terms of Service ("Terms") apply to all use of the BareWanderer website and all services, activities, workshops, tours, and products offered by BareWanderer ("BareWanderer", "we", "us", or "our").

By accessing our Website or booking any service, you agree to these Terms.

1. About BareWanderer

BareWanderer operates as a freelance (self-employed / ZZP) outdoor brand offering services including, but not limited to:

- Outdoor workshops and education (including for primary schools)
- Ranger, guiding, and outdoor facilitation services
- Glamping, site management, and operations support
- Future guided tours and outdoor experiences
- Digital content and physical products (if applicable)

2. Applicability

These Terms apply to:

- All visitors of the Website
- All customers and participants in services, workshops, and tours
- All agreements concluded with BareWanderer

Deviations from these Terms are only valid if agreed in writing.

3. Bookings and Agreements

A booking or agreement is confirmed when:

- A booking is made via the Website, email, or other communication channel, and
- BareWanderer confirms the booking

BareWanderer reserves the right to refuse bookings without stating reasons.

4. Prices and Payment

- All prices are stated in EUR unless otherwise specified
- Prices may include or exclude VAT depending on applicable regulations
- Payment terms will be specified per service or invoice
- Late payments may result in cancellation or additional charges

5. Cancellation and Refund Policy

Unless otherwise agreed:

For consumers (EU law):

- You may have a statutory right of withdrawal within 14 days, unless:
 - the service is scheduled within that period, or
 - it concerns leisure activities with a specific date

For workshops, events, and tours:

- Cancellation by the participant:
 - up to 14 days before: full refund
 - 7 - 14 days before: 50% refund
 - within 7 days: no refund
- Cancellation by BareWanderer:
 - we may cancel due to weather, safety concerns, or unforeseen circumstances
 - in such cases, a refund or rescheduling will be offered

6. Participation and Risk

Participation in outdoor activities is at your own risk.

By participating, you confirm that:

- You are physically and mentally fit to take part
- You follow instructions given by BareWanderer
- You understand the inherent risks involved

For minors a parent, guardian, or school is responsible for consent and supervision agreements.

7. Liability

To the fullest extent permitted by law:

BareWanderer is not liable for:

- Injuries, accidents, or damages during activities
- Loss or theft of personal belongings
- Indirect or consequential damages

Liability is only accepted in cases of intent or gross negligence.

Nothing in these Terms excludes liability where prohibited by Dutch or EU law.

8. Force Majeure

BareWanderer shall not be held liable for failure to perform obligations due to events beyond reasonable control, including:

- Extreme weather
- Natural disasters
- Government restrictions
- Illness or emergencies

9. Code of Conduct

Participants must:

- Respect nature, locations, and other participants
- Follow safety instructions at all times
- Behave appropriately

BareWanderer reserves the right to remove participants without refund in case of misconduct.

10. Workshops and Schools

For workshops involving children or schools:

- The school or organization remains responsible for supervision unless agreed otherwise
- Medical or special needs must be communicated in advance
- Appropriate insurance is recommended

11. Intellectual Property

All content, branding, and materials provided by BareWanderer remain our intellectual property.

They may not be copied, distributed, or used without written permission.

12. Media and Photography

BareWanderer may take photos or videos during activities for promotional purposes. Participants will be informed in advance and may opt out where reasonably possible. For minors, consent must be provided by a parent, guardian, or institution.

13. Privacy

Personal data is processed in accordance with our [Privacy Policy](#).

14. Third Parties

BareWanderer may collaborate with third parties (e.g., locations, partners, guides). We are not responsible for their actions unless legally required.

15. Changes to Services

BareWanderer reserves the right to:

- Modify programs, routes, or activities
- Adjust schedules
- Substitute instructors or locations

This may occur due to safety, weather, or operational reasons.

16. Governing Law and Jurisdiction

These Terms are governed by the laws of the Netherlands.

Any disputes shall be submitted to the competent court in the Netherlands.
